A virus called HPV causes all of these problems!

Facts about HPV

- What is HPV?
 - HPV is short for *human papilloma virus*. It is the most common sexually transmitted virus in the United States. This is a group of over 150 related viruses. Of these, about 3 out of 4 (75%) cause warts on the skin—most often arms, chest, hands and feet. The other 25% cause warts in the mouth, vagina, and anus (where it is moist.)
- The HPV vaccine helps prevent the infections which cause 70% of all cervical cancers and pre-cancers. Also, helps against 2 types that cause 90% of genital warts.
- HPV can cause cervical cancer. 2nd leading cause of cancer deaths in the world. In U.S., about 10,000 get cervical cancer each year and about 4,000 are expected to die from
